7:00 Continued Notice of Intent, Glenn Hersh, 470 Cooper Creek, an addition, remove and build a new garage, upgrade the septic and improve drainage within 100' Buffer Zone wetland and bank bordering on Goose Pond. Continued to March 15 @ 8:00.

7:30 Notice of Intent, Town of Lee, Construction of Skateboard at 126 Housatonic. Continued to March 15 @ 8:15

7:45 Request for an Extension Permit for the Aquatic Management Program at Fox Hollow Ponds, DEP File # 196-280

The original permit was granted in 2001. The original extension expired March 27, 2007. At this time they received a second extension through March 2010. This will be the third extension that is being requested citing the same reasons as the prior extension. In a letter submitted by Aquatic Control, no treatment has been conducted since 2006. Concern was expressed that over time, things may change. Ms. Hansen pointed out that this is a man-made pond, probably has a bottom liner, is isolated, no fish and does not drain into anything. These ponds are mainly for ascetics and not recreational purposes. A motion was made by Mr. Philpott to grant only one more extension good for one year. Any further applications will require the submission of a new NOI. Seconded by Ms. Hansen. Unanimously approved.

Other Business:

- A car had gone into Laurel Lake off the boat ramp however this is not under conservation's jurisdiction but that of the environmental police.

- It was noted that F.L. Roberts has withdrawn from the project he submitted at the Diesel Dan's
- Work has begun at the Mobile Station. Stuart Seine needs to update the paperwork. Page 10 of the OOC has not been stamped and signed by the Registry prior to the filing. Mr. Seine stated that the documents can be viewed at the data base online. Ms. Garry requested that the paperwork be processed completely and submitted to the Commission.
