

Summer 2011 Sandy Beach Parking Permits Plan Explanation
June 16, 2011

Effective June 18, 2011, a beach parking pass will be required for access to the parking area at Lee Sandy Beach. The passes are restricted to Lee residents (seasonal and year round), their guests, and paying guests of motels, B&B's Inns, and October Mtn. State Park campground. Access to Sandy Beach is through private property and is allowed with use of these passes from 10am to 8pm from June 18, 2011 through September 5, 2011.

The passes may be picked up at any time at the Lee Dispatch Center in Town Hall. Passes may also be picked up from the parking attendant at Sandy Beach when he is on duty. Proof of residency is required for the Resident Parking Pass which is valid for the season.

One-day Guest Parking Passes are also available for guests of Lee residents. The resident must obtain pass for guest. Paying guests of motels, B&B's and Inns located within the Town of Lee as well as campers at October Mt. State Park campground may also obtain a one-day guest pass. Proof of lodging is required to obtain this pass for these guests.
