Stretch Energy Code

The Town of Lee is Considering Becoming a "Green Community"...

On January 1 of this year, the state transitioned to a new building code. The new building code contains an optional Appendix—the Stretch Energy Code—that communities can adopt to go slightly “above and beyond” the new code, requiring buildings to be more energy efficient.

Adoption of the Stretch Energy Code is one of the five criteria communities must meet to achieve Green Community designation and be eligible to apply for Green Community grant funds.

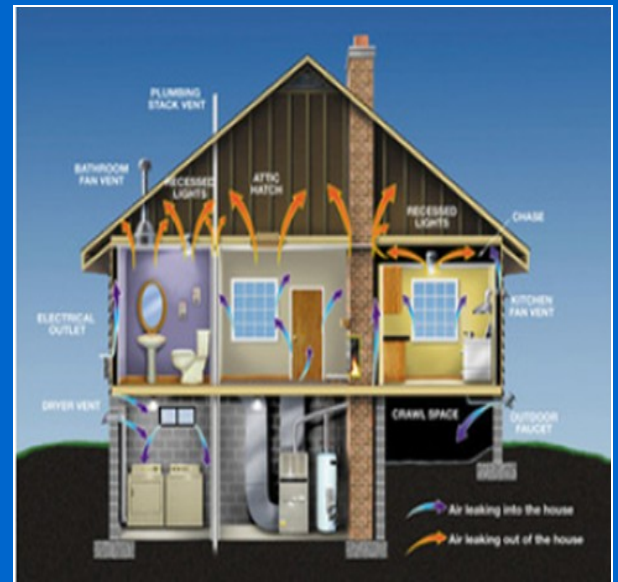
