The Division confirmed that further study would be needed, a report on all the methods, data and conclusions needs to be submitted. LLPA is still approved for the 3-foot drawdown as approved in 2018. 5 Chanterwood Road Map 33 Lot 10 Dead tree endangering a cottage This was an informational presentation of future work. Mr. Farley presented the plan. The plan is to take down trees that endanger property, construct a wheelchair ramp, and build a retaining wall at the lake end of the wheelchair ramp. The ramp to be built and most of the trees to be taken down will be/are on 9 Chanterwood. This will involve the removal of 16 trees. Straw wattles and silt fencing will be the erosion controls used. There was discussion as to erosion that could occur with the removal of the trees. The work is on two properties, 5 Chanterwood Road, owned by Mr. Farley and 9 Chanterwood Road owned by Economous. The ad for a NOI has been submitted to the Eagle and will be published on Tuesday, September 27, 2022.

Discussion on 300 Valenti Drive. Mr. Philpott. No SMA will be required and there are no wetlands on the property. There is an intermittent stream that is on an abutting lot. The owner of the property was going to submit plans to be reviewed by the Commission, but none have been submitted.
