1. Failure to comply with all conditions slated herein, and with all related statutes and other regulatory measures, shall be deemed cause to revoke or modify this Order.

that the following conditions modify or differ from the plans, specifications or other proposals submitted with the Notice of Intent, the conditions shall

- 2. This Order does not grant any property rights or any exclusive privileges; it does not authorize any injury to private property or invasion of private rights.
- 3. This Order does not relieve the permittee or any other person of the necessity of complying with all other applicable federal, state or local statutes, ordinances, by-laws or regulations.
- 4. The work authorized hereunder shall be commenced within one year following the date of issuance of this order and shall thereafter prosecute diligently such activity to completion. Failure to commence said activity within one year of issuance shall constitute an abandonment of the project and the Conservation Commission, after reasonable notice to the applicant, may revoke the Order.
- 5. This Order shall expire two years after the date of issuance and may be extended by the issuing authority for two periods of up to one year each upon application to the issuing authority at least 30 days prior to the expiration date of the Order.
- 6. Any fill used in connection with this project shall be clean fill, containing no trash, refuse, rubbish, branches, tree limbs, brush, or debris, including but not limited to lumber, bricks, plaster, wire, lath, paper, cardboard, pipe, tires, ashes, appliances, motor vehicles or parts of any of the foregoing.
- 7. No work shall be undertaken until all administrative appeal periods from this Order have elapsed or, if such an appeal has been filed, until all proceedings before the Department have been completed.
- 8. No work shall be undertaken until the Final Order has been recorded in the Berkshire Middle District Registry of Deeds or the Land Court for the district in which the land is located, within the chain of title of the affected property. In the case of recorded land, the Final Order shall also be noted in the Registry's Grant or Index under the name of the owner of the land upon which the proposed work is to be done. In the case of registered land, the Final Order shall also be noted on the Land Court Certificate of Title of the owner of the land upon which the proposed work is to be done. The recording information shall be submitted to the Conservation Commission on the form at the end of this order prior to commencement of work.
