Interim Town Administrator Christopher Brittain stated that the FY23 budget process is in the works. He also mentioned that the AG's office approved the new dog license law change.

The Legislature will look at the special act changing from representative town meeting to an open town meeting pending a referendum in the town election in May.

The ARPA survey is available on our website for suggestions on how or what to use the ARPA money for. Select Board member Bob Jones asked if we know when the town would start disseminating the funds. Patty stated that cities and towns are still in the process; we're not last, and we're not first. Pittsfield and Williamstown took the same survey as we did in order to get information from the people which will be open for discussion until December 24<sup>th</sup>, with the results around the first of the year.

The Board discussed whether we could go back to "in-person" meetings. Chris Brittain advised that we wait until after our November 16<sup>th</sup> meeting as we have a hearing on that date for which we have already published it in our agenda and in the Berkshire Eagle notifications that it would be a ZOOM meeting.

Sean Regnier announced that the Eagle Mill ground breaking ceremony will be on November 10<sup>th</sup>.
