- j) <u>Appalachian Trail Community Discussion</u> Patty Carlino, Chair introduced this discussion which was spearheaded by Debbie Cranwell to propose that we appoint a committee to help engage

with the Appalachian Trail Community hikers. Sean offered that he is interested in the committee. Patty asked Interim Town Administrator Chris Brittain if he would put this on our town website and we can perhaps begin the process. She explained that she has heard a takes a year or more to get approved. The Board members formally agreed that they would begin the process. Patty added to the discussion that the Appalachian Trail emphasizes on having an educator and having a teacher be a part of the community discussion and she will notify the school.

k) <u>Kathy Hall – Updates</u> - Kathy came before the Board with an update on the skating rink. She said that it is coming along and needs perhaps a couple more weeks to completely freeze over. She will notify when it is ready. She also thanked everyone for giving their time and help in this endeavor. Kathy has also been in touch with BerryDunn regarding the "Proposed" Community Center and they are still wrapping up the marketing analysis. They are looking at other communities with similar things that we're looking for in the area of 10-60 miles from Lee. The financial feasibility study is ready and a draft should reach us sometime in mid January and it will be presented and explained to the Select Board at a meeting.

The Board discussed staying with ZOOM meetings for the foreseeable future and everyone was on the same page regarding keeping things safe for the time being, at least through the month of January as both meeting dates in January have hearings scheduled and the postings must match the form of meeting.
