- ➤ Continued Notice of Intent for Berkshire Wireless 115 Run Way DEP#196-0444 Ms Gapinski reviewed the project in detail. A site inspection verified the proposed extension of the driveway. The drive way will have an airport mix allowing proper drainage. The front loading dock construction was approved. The improvement of the riverfront issue was resolved by removing a farm access bridge across Willow Creek. No "Banking" of compensatory storage is allowed for future use. Motion to approve by K. - > Stockbridge Terrace LLC Enforcement Order The proposed meeting of all parties was postponed because of schedule conflicts and rescheduled for April 11<sup>th</sup>.
- ➤ David Lane approached the Commission on a proposed garage in the back of his property. There was a question of whether or not his site plan was accurate. The elevations used were from a Google Map and not the official FEMA maps. Mr. Lane was advised to check with the Town Building Inspector to determine the proper elevations marking out the flood plain before he proceeds and come back to the Commission with an updated plain.
- ➤ Peter Navinti came before the Commission to request a site visit before the wet land scientist looked at his property on the 11<sup>th</sup>. The Commissioners accepted Peter's invitation and scheduled a visit for April 7<sup>th</sup>.
- The Commissioners asked Mr. Wickham if he would research the drawdown issues at Laurel Lake and report back to the commissioner his findings.
