- ➤ Continued Stockbridge Terrace LLC Enforcement Order Restoration Plan Ms. Glover was concerned about others not coming to the meeting. The two parties involved in the issue are working well together and are waiting until they get more feedback from DEP. There was an issue with the work at the detention basin and Tri Town Health came in and checked the site. The work then resumed as the tests showed all was well. Ms. Naventi cited the Enforcement Order Conditions #13 and #14 that need to be followed. Ms. Arment reaffirmed that there needs to be a Restoration Plan presented at the next meeting on August 1, 2018.
- > Ms. Hansen has noticed that there is house construction going on at the red house on Greylock Street across from the cove. The house is by a stream/river. Ms. Vsetecka will ask the building department about the issuance of a building permit.
- Consideration of Laurel Lake Preservation Association Permits There was a call by Mr. Stinson at DEP that the Order of Conditions DEP #196-0371 had been closed out with a Certificate of Compliance issued.
