7:00 PM. Berkshire Gas Company Update. Steve Robare representing Berkshire Gas Company updated the Commission about their work on Mill Street. All the paperwork was completed in 2012 but the project was delayed till 2013. Berkshire Gas will be starting the project the week of the 25th of March. Straw waddles and silt fences will surround the area where work will be done in the Washington Brook section. The wetlands which will be affected will be replicated as per the Orders of Conditions. The Commissioners will inspect the site as needed. The plan calls for the new gas main trenches to be back filled each day.
