Lee- On behalf of the Tri-Town Health District, working in conjunction with the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, we are hereby issuing a public health advisory regarding the identification of a harmful algae bloom being identified near the west end of Laurel Lake in Lenox MA.

Recreational activities such as swimming, fishing, or boating are highly discouraged near this area and we are advising to stay away from this area until such time this advisory is eliminated.

Entry signs of the Lake will be posted with this advisory.
