- **Extension Request for Order of Conditions Commonwealth of Massachusetts DEP #196-0378**
Mr. Brazeau stated that after 10 years of working on the project, the funding for it has now been received. The project is both in Lee and Washington and in an Area of Critical Concern. The lower part is in a NHESP area. The Order of Conditions and the plan for the project were passed out to the Commissioners for their review. The flagging will be rechecked before work commences. Any conditions in the original Order will still be valid. Mr. Brazeau will contact the Commission when the erosion controls are ready to be inspected.
Motion made and seconded to approve the 3 year extension. Unanimous approval
- **100 Church Street Drainage issue Mr. and Mrs. Bauman** The Baumans stated that there is a drainage issue on this property because of a 12' pipe that shoots water onto it. A ditch/drainage system was put in at some time and has not been maintained. The Baumans have been in touch with the DWP and Mr. Nason and nothing has been done. They are asking if the Commission has any jurisdiction over any of the area and can help them with the problem as they are concerned that eventually the land will become a wetland. The Commission will take a look at the property and will talk to others about it. Then they will make a decision as to whether there is anything they can do to help alleviate the problem.
- **Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes of the September 2, 2015 meeting. Unanimous approval**
- **Mr. Philpott stated that the erosion controls at 210 Stockbridge Road were inspected and were fine**
- **Channel between Upper and Lower Goose Pond.** A report was received that someone was throwing rocks into the channel to supposedly make it shallower. Also, there is a sign posting a speed limit there. That sign is illegal. The Environmental Police set the speed limit and there is none for that area. No one knows who put the sign up. When it is known did that, the Commission will write a letter and ask that the sign be removed.
- **Motion made and seconded to adjourn at 8:15 PM. Unanimous approval.**
