Septic Receiving Policy:

Hours for receiving septage are Monday thru Friday 7am -2:30 pm

Septic is allowed from all communities, with the stipulation that no Greece is allowed.

Currently we have been allowing up 10k to 15k gal per day. It has been suggested to all haulers to call the W.W.T.P. during pm hrs to ensure dumping will be allowed.

Currently all haulers have a septage station access card, that allows them to discharge automatically. Information such as who the hauler is, what the ph is and the number of gallons discharged is recorded onto the plant scada. Also a receipt is also available to the driver at the site that gives all the above information.

When the septic receiving station is down due to mechanical problems haulers will be allowed to discharge septic into a designated manhole that ensures revenue will not be lost, Also this location will allow proper screening to be done .In this case a septic slip is filled out in the office with the required information. The driver receives a slip and the W.W.T.P. keeps the original for billing.

It is understood to all haulers that septic may be not allowed due to operational problems. If for any reason septic is not allowed for an extended period of time the haulers will be contacted with this information.

The following conditions will also be required before dumping.

1. PH. Should be within 6.5 - 8.5
2. No Greece traps.
3. Septage should have characteristics of household septage , such as B.O.D & T.SS
4. Cleanup of area after dumping is required.
