

# LEE NORTHERN MILLS AREA-WIDE PLAN



**COME SEE OUR DISPLAY AT THE BABY TOWN MEETING!**

The Town of Lee received a Brownfields Area-Wide Planning Grant from the EPA to develop a plan for the Eagle, Columbia, Greylock, and Niagara mills. The Town is working with the Berkshire Regional Planning Commission and will be completing the plan in September 2016.

This is an opportunity to plan for the area as a whole and to consider the potential impacts to surrounding areas, including the downtown, rather than planning for each site separately. It also provides an opportunity for the **community** to be heard and let the developers know what the community thinks. Developers can learn about community concerns, how to address these concerns upfront and identify reuse concepts that already have the community's support.
