Legal

Northampton Attorney Michael Pill's interesting quote with potential applications for resisting 5G. He's speaking about the right of way and the plan to put a microwave tower on Legate Hill in Charlemont: "Perhaps WiValley or the Charlemont Selectboard are under the likely misconception that the town owns outright the land within the bounds of the public way; they may be unaware of the derelict fee statute (G.L. c. 183, § 58) and the judicial presumption (established by Mass. court decisions) that a public way is only an easement, with the fee (meaning ownership of the land) remaining in the abutting landowners." Michael represented Charlemont residents.
